for the time being) of the other Part.

WHEREAS the said founder owns and possesses
a sum of Rupees five thousand in his Account No.
P.8/1696 in the State Bank of India, Pithapur,
Cuttack as his self-acquired property over which
he has full disposing power under the Hindu law ;-

AND WHEREAS the said founder is desirous of
settling the said sum in a trust for public welfare
in Orissa in cherished memory of his late wife Adhya-
pika Niharika Das to be called "Adhyapika Niharika
Das Memorial Trust" in manner herein after appearing.

NOW THIS DEED WITNESSES AS FOLLOWS :-

1. The Trustees shall hold the sum of Rupees five
thousand (herein after referred to as the trust fund)
paid to them by the founder upon trust to apply the
income thereof in perpetuity for promotion and mainte-
nance of such projects and schemes of public welfare in
Orissa as may be decided upon by them from time to time.
2. Without prejudice to the generality of the power
or discretion conferred on the trustees in the foregoing
para, the income of the trust fund may be applied to the
following purposes -
 - a) To award a prize in cash with citation to the
student of Cuttack City College, Cuttack (where
late Niharika Das served as a Lecturer in History
since its inception) securing the highest mark
in History in the Higher Secondary Examination
annually.

- b) To publish a Souvenir in memory of late Niharika Das compiling articles from her students, colleagues, relatives and others.
- c) To organise a seminar once in two years on a suitable subject on History or any allied subject and publish the papers placed in the seminar as a memorial volume on late Niharika Das.
- d) To publish the materials collected by late Niharika Das as a part of her Ph.D. work on late Nabakrushna Choudhury.
- e) To extend financial help to the poor students of any school/College in Orissa to enable them to prosecute their studies.
- f) To provide news papers and magazines to the remote areas of Orissa for defusion of knowledge and information.
- g) To take up any other project or scheme of public welfare as decided by the trustees from time to time.

3. All powers or discretions conferred on the trustees shall be exercised by them and all the decisions shall be taken by a simple majority of votes in a meeting called for the purpose. At least 15 days prior notice shall be given of any meeting of the trustees indicating the agenda of the meeting.

4. The Trustees shall every three years elect from amongst them 1 trustee to be the President who shall function as such till his successor is elected. The President shall preside over all meetings and in his absence at any particular meeting the Trustees present may elect one of them to act as the President for that meeting.

5. There shall be two Managing Trustees of whom the founder shall be the ex-officio managing trustee. The Managing Trustees shall be responsible for the day to day management of the affairs of the Trust and they

shall operate the bank accounts, make payments, receive grants and make valid discharge of dues payable to the trust jointly. Either of them shall be the convener of all meetings.

Before the President and the Managing Trustee are elected as herein provided, Dr. Dhaneswar Mohapatra and Dr. Sushanta Kumar Das shall be the President and the Managing Trustee respectively.

6. Any Trustee may resign from his office by writing under his hand addressed to the other Trustees collectively. Any Trustee may be removed by unanimous vote of all the remaining Trustees in a meeting called for the purpose.

7. If any Office of the Trustee, including the President and the Managing Trustees, falls vacant by resignation, removal, death or otherwise, the remaining Trustees may fill up the vacancy by appointing any person in the vacancy as a Trustee in a meeting called for the purpose.

8. The Trustees may for carrying out its purposes acquire by gift, grant, donation, or otherwise, hold and dispose of property and make contracts with any person or Government.

9. The Trust is deemed to be operative with effect from the date of execution of this deed as mentioned above.
